



On August 24, 2015, the parties filed another stipulation, this time regarding attorney's fees and costs. ECF No. 59. Petitioner requests reimbursement of attorney's fees and costs in the amount of \$26,000.00. *Id.* This amount represents a sum to which Respondent does not object. *Id.* In addition, and in compliance with General Order No. 9, Petitioner's counsel represents that Petitioner did not personally incur any expenses in litigating this case. *Id.*

I approve the requested amount for attorney's fees and costs as reasonable. Accordingly, an award of \$26,000.00 shall be made in the form of a check payable jointly to Petitioner and Petitioner's counsel, F. John Caldwell, Jr., Esq. Payment of this amounts represents all attorney's fees and costs available under 42 U.S.C. § 300aa-15(e). In the absence of a motion for review filed pursuant to RCFC Appendix B, the clerk of the court **SHALL ENTER JUDGMENT** in accordance with the terms of the parties' stipulation.<sup>3</sup>
