



On September 3, 2014, counsel for both parties filed another joint stipulation, this time regarding attorneys' fees and costs. The parties have stipulated that Petitioner's counsel should receive a lump sum of \$23,205.59, in the form of a check payable to Petitioner and Petitioner's counsel. Additionally, the parties have stipulated that Petitioner should receive a lump sum of \$200.00, in the form of a check payable to Petitioner. These amounts represent sums to which Respondent does not object.

I approve the requested amount for attorneys' fees and costs as well as the requested amount for Petitioner's out-of-pocket expenses as reasonable. Accordingly, an award of \$23,205.59 should be made in the form of a check payable jointly to Petitioner and Petitioner's counsel, Thomas P. Gallagher, Esq.; and an award of \$200.00 should be made in the form of a check payable to Petitioner. In the absence of a motion for review filed pursuant to RCFC Appendix B, the clerk of the court **SHALL ENTER JUDGMENT** in accordance with the terms of the parties' stipulation.<sup>2</sup>
