

caused by vaccination. On January 5, 2015, an Order Concluding Proceedings was entered dismissing the petition without prejudice.

On January 29, 2015, petitioners filed an application for attorneys' fees and costs. On February 9, 2015, the parties filed a Stipulation of Facts Concerning Attorneys' Fees and Costs. According to the stipulation, the parties stipulate to a total award to petitioners of attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$12,291.81. In accordance with General Order #9, petitioners' counsel states that petitioners personally incurred \$400.00, in costs in pursuit of their claim.

The Vaccine Act permits an award of reasonable attorneys' fees and costs. 42 U.S.C. § 300 aa-15(e). Based on the reasonableness of petitioners' request and the lack of any objection by respondent, the undersigned **GRANTS** the request for approval and payment of attorneys' fees and costs.

Accordingly, an award should be made as follows:

- (1) in the form of a check jointly payable to petitioners and to petitioners' attorney, Mark L. Krueger, in the amount of \$12,291.81, and
- (2) in the form of a check payable to petitioners only in the amount of \$400.00.

In the absence of a motion for review filed pursuant to RCFC Appendix B, the clerk of the court **SHALL ENTER JUDGMENT** in accordance with the terms of the parties' stipulation.³

IT IS SO ORDERED.
