Accordingly, pursuant to Vaccine Rule 21(a) the above-captioned case is hereby **dismissed without prejudice**. The Clerk of the Court is hereby instructed that a **judgment shall not enter** in the instant case pursuant to Vaccine Rule 21(a).

³ Although the parties filed the stipulation requesting that a decision dismissing the case be issued with prejudice, the undersigned's chambers contact the parties to advise that under Vaccine Rule 21(a), an order concluding proceedings would be issued, dismissing the case without prejudice. While counsel for respondent preferred that the case be dismissed with prejudice, counsel did not object to having the case dismissed without prejudice. Counsel for petitioner also had no objection to dismissing the case without prejudice.
